## THE WORLD

**Instruction:** Dot to dot - World Map. (Australia 1-10) (Asia/Europe 11-35) (Africa 40-54) (Americas 60-88) (Antarctica 90-94)

The main map is a dot-to-dot activity for a world map. It features the following elements:

- Continents and Oceans:** Labeled with text: North America, South America, Europe, Asia, Africa, Australia, Arctic Ocean, Atlantic Ocean, Indian Ocean, Pacific Ocean, and Southern Ocean.
- Numbered Dots:** Dots are numbered from 1 to 94, corresponding to the instruction. Some numbers are already connected by lines to form parts of the map.
- Animal Icons:** Silhouettes of animals representing each continent: a bison for North America, a fish for South America, a squirrel for Europe, a bear for Asia, a lion for Africa, a kangaroo for Australia, and a penguin for Antarctica.
